(HAFAD)**. “Public discourse should be grounded in facts and respect, not generalizations that dehumanize entire populations.”

Haiti holds deep historical significance as the world’s first Black republic, and Haitian communities continue to contribute significantly to healthcare, education, and the U.S. workforce.

The organization urges media leaders, policymakers, and public figures to ensure that discussions about immigration remain factual, respectful, and grounded in human dignity.
